**FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 23**

Explanation of materials, surfaces, and approaches to developing a preliminary study  
Introduction to the concept and process of developing a preliminary study (value renderings with emphasis on the elements and principles of design)  
Learning how to design a vignette in order to maintain the natural whites of the painting surface  
Individual instruction regarding students' preliminary study assignments  
Review daily assignments

**SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 24**

Students will meet at The Toledo Artists' Club facility for indoor instruction  
Students will learn different concepts and approaches for transferring their preliminary compositional study to their painting surface  
Discussion regarding the characteristic qualities of different painting surfaces  
Introduction to underglazes, lost-and-found, and negative painting  
Individual instruction regarding students' painting assignments  
Review daily assignments

**SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 25**

Students will meet at The Toledo Artists' Club facility for indoor instruction  
Review and "question/answer" session regarding previous lectures and assignments  
Demonstration and lecture regarding special requests from students  
Introduction to the process of developing a "wet on wet" watercolor painting  
Individual instruction regarding their painting assignments  
Review daily assignments
