Scott was born in Fremont, Ohio; his mother is a painter and quilt maker and his father is a woodworker. His parents instilled all their children with aesthetics sensibilities. Painting, drawing, building things from wood, playing musical instruments and singing were all a natural part of his early home life. He received a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, studying under painters Susanna Coffey and Rufino Silva. Crowds of people, buildings, and city streets are frequent subjects in his work. Since 1990 Scott has received more than 30 awards or acceptances into gallery shows, including being accepted eight times into the Toledo Area Artists Annual Exhibit at the Toledo Museum of Art.

ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists` Club members and area artists.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, three-D, ceramics, glass.

Entries may be images or items representing any theme or subject.

ENTRY FEE: TAC members: \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00 (**Voucher for 2nd entry: \$10 discount**)
No Refunds **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: Three (3) works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars).
 Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size: 36" x 48". TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.*

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open starting on Sunday, May 27. Accepted works can be picked up when the club is open after the show closes. **EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD.**

SALES: ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.
 All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 30% commission.
