The show's subject: "Where in Toledo" includes our rivers, lakes and fields of grain, trees, gardens, fishing and sailing activities, plus a classroom in our own TMA.

Each artist's personal vision shows how beautiful and dramatic our Toledo area is. From realistic renderings to impressionistic creativeness, the story told, the aspirations of these artists, show that they are perfecting their forms of expression and expanding their abilities.

Much thought has gone into this show, and I encourage you to look for the freshness of composition and a wide range of expression. The works receiving the awards were chosen for:

- Values of light and dark with repeated variation
- Color harmony and variation
- Shape/motif with transitional forms
- Variety of spacing
- Line and edge variation
- Focus and a central idea
- Unity/harmony
- Subjective response: Did this hold my attention?

This is a strong show and a pleasure to view.

Please be set up and ready to go by 11 am and plan to have your display open until 5 pm. If the weather is bad, you may close up early. You may park close to your booth for set up and tear down. Please park on Olimphia Drive during event hours. Art demonstrations are encouraged but not required. You must provide your own tent, tables, chairs, etc.

I am a nail technician and bookkeeper by trade, living in Sylvania, Ohio, but my true passion is photography. I picked up a camera in the late 90's and never looked back. I am self-taught and have always been interested in different forms of art. I really enjoy shooting fine art, portraits, landscapes, cityscapes and nature shots. One day I came upon some unique photographs of smoke and I knew I could create similar works of art. I love this type of creativity because it allows me to engage in both art and photography. All the pieces begin as photographs of incense smoke, which become the focus of creating an art print. While viewing the photos, some images become apparent to me while some need to be teased out of their raw form. Some images remain natural and abstract, while others interpret a concept. Either way, the work is done in a digital dark room, where I design and hand tint each and every image.

ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists` Club members.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, sculpture, three-D, ceramics, glass.

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00 **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars). Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size*: 36" x 48". *TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable*.

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD. Exhibited works must be picked up within 30

days of the show's end.

SALES: ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.

All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 30% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
