Juror's Comments: As clichéd as it sounds this was a tough show to judge with so many wonderful artists. I chose the seven winners based on the simplicity of design and the force of their execution. Paul Brand's *Salsa* has just the right blend of structure and spontaneity. Marsha McHugh's painting *Springtime* with its bright colors floating in sunshine is just where I want to be. *Trellis* by Claire Wilson is a dance of sunlight colors while *They'll Grow Anywhere* by Kathy Palmer Genzman juxtaposes new growth over tangled waste. The Honorable Mentions, *Reflections* by Randi Lowry, *Alchemy* by Joan Rigal and *Sunflowers* by Ellie Miller are all strong and beautifully executed paintings. To those that didn't win an award this time "Bravo!"

	ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars). Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). <i>Maximum framed size: 36" x 48". TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.</i>	
PICK-UP:	Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD. Exhibited works must be picked up within 30 days of the show's end.	
SALES:	ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED. All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 30% commission.
