Message from the Trustees

Thanks to everyone who assisted with the Artists Lounge for the Crosby Festival of the Arts. Helping with this premier event, the biggest fundraiser for the Garden, enhances our reputation with the Garden administration while helping to meet our volunteer needs for the garden.

In order to reduce expenses in preparation for the potential increase in our lease payment, Cynthia Hoot, our Office Administrator, generously suggested that we reduce her hours. The Board agreed that Cynthia will no longer work on Saturdays, keeping in mind that very few people visit the club on Saturdays. To keep the club open on Saturdays, we will ask for volunteers just as we do for Sundays. Cynthia's last Saturday to work will be June 24. To accommodate our members, who visit the club mostly on Tuesdays and Thursdays, she will increase her time by one hour on those days, working from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm, with the club open from 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm. This will result in an annual savings of approximately \$1700.00. During the Zimbabwe Sculpture Exhibit at the Garden September and October, we anticipate that the number of visitors to the Garden will increase so there may be more visitors to the club than usual. Therefore Cynthia will work Saturdays for those two months, returning to her new schedule starting in November.

Please volunteer to keep the club open on Saturday or Sunday. A volunteer signup sheet will be on the table in the studio. The first Saturday that we will require a volunteer will be July 8. We hope that the TAC members will step up and help keep the club open on Saturdays throughout the year just as they have done for Sundays during the summer months.

At the June meeting of the Trustees, these officers were elected: Treasurer Faye Edinger, Secretary Paul Brand, President Richard Carle. Rich will continue to serve as President for one more year.

Juror's comments: It was an honor to be asked to jury this show. Several works that jumped out at me and although there weren't as many entries as usual, the work was outstanding making it difficult to choose award winners.

I choose CAROL SICHA'S acrylic painting, "Remember" as best of show because it reminded me of visiting my Uncle Buddy's farm on Sundays and my father walking all of us children to the barn to see the animals. I don't think it gets more American than that.

JULIE DRAEGER'S work, "Lakeside Porch" was fantastic. I loved the color choices, the painted border around the image, and the brush strokes. This work put me in mind of Vincent Van Gough, one of my favorite artists and with the hint of the flag in the background bold yet subtle, made me think of our country.

MARK WATSON'S oil painting, "Grandpa's House" was just lovely, tranquil, and I thought very accomplished in style and use of color. CLAIRE WILSON'S mixed media piece,

"Canyon Colors" reminded me of the quilts that my grandmother hand stitched using old worn out clothing and sugar sacks. The colors and textures were stunning. ELLIE MILLER'S watercolor, "Alaska Cabin" was a delightful well-executed piece. MARTI HUEPENBECKER'S photo, "Hometown U.S. A." was charming, putting me in mind of small town America.

PAUL SNEIDER'S oil painting, "America's Riverboat Era" used intricate detail, which made the work intriguing. Thank you for the opportunity to select work from such an accomplished group of artists.

ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists` Club members and area artists.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, sculpture, three-D, ceramics, glass.

Theme Description: Artists may choose to depict cityscapes, skyscrapers, street scenes, urban living spaces OR pastoral scenes, barns, sheds, fence posts, farm houses.

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00
No Refunds **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars).
Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size: 36" x 48". TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.*

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. **EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD.** Exhibited works must be picked up within 30 days of the show's end.

SALES: **ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.**
All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 25% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
