Message from the Trustees

Happy Fall to all TAC members. The financial results for the summer were down due to low participation in the June and July Gallery exhibitions. However, the August exhibition was very good. Total cash reserves for TAC at the end of August were \$20,839.42. CLAIRE WILSON and CAROL SICHA submitted the themes for the gallery exhibitions in 2018; the list was approved and accepted by the board. See pages 2 & 3 for details.

The last big fundraiser for our club in 2017 is Heralding the Holidays. Pam Alspach is making a huge effort so that this event will be a success. With the Metroparks now having management of the Botanical Gardens, the Resident Organizations are responsible for organizing this event. Please actively participate and assist Pam in her efforts. Pam has scheduled two sessions at the club, **Wednesday October 11, 10 AM to 2 PM, and Sunday, October 15, 1 to 4 PM** to make ceramic ornaments boxes and bookmarks to be sold at Heralding the Holidays.

The next Member's Meeting is Wednesday, October 11, starting at 6:00pm. The membership will get an update on the role the Metroparks in managing the Garden. Tom Sorrell will present a demonstration of painting on Yupo, a plastic "paper" that has become popular with watercolorists. His demo will highlight some of the techniques and equipment used to create the free flowing and textured effects that make painting on Yupo both exciting and challenging.

Starting in November, Cynthia will revert to working only on Tuesdays and Thursdays in an effort to cut TAC expenses. However, the club should remain open on Saturdays. We are asking for volunteers for Saturday Sitters through November and December. It is important the members step up if the club is to continue to be an asset to the Gardens.

Any work done with an instructor is a joint venture and if it is successful in entering a show, the success belongs to two people. The whole point of an artwork is that it is an original creation. For these reasons in the Prospectus for every club show this statement is included: "Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop)."



ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists` Club members and area artists.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, sculpture, three-D, ceramics, glass.

Theme Description: This can be a formal or informal sitting of one or more people, present in any style, from a realistic rendition to different degrees of abstraction.

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00 *No Refunds* **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars). Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size*: 36" x 48". *TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.*

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING

 $FOR\ THE\ DURATION\ OF\ THE\ SHOW\ UNLESS\ IT\ IS\ SOLD.\ Exhibited\ works\ must\ be\ picked\ up\ within\ 30$

days of the show's end.

SALES: ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.

All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 25% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
