Message from the Trustees

For the third consecutive Gallery Show, we had an outstanding number of artists submit works for the Artist's Choice Exhibition. Also, the quality of the works submitted was superb. Thanks to all the artists who participated.

There appears to be some confusion regarding placement of the art tags on works submitted for the TAC gallery shows. We have included two photos of a properly placed tag on page 4, and will post it on the bulletin board in the Studio. Also, we are reminding all artists to read the ***Guidelines for Submitting Artwork to Toledo Artists' Club***, which is summarized in each prospectus, and in more detail on our website (<https://toledoartistclub.com/>) under "Exhibitions". Recently, there have been a few pieces submitted that do not meet the guidelines. Take-in volunteers will work with any artist who does not know the requirements but will also reject any piece that does not meet the guidelines.

There is a new sign-up sheet in the studio for Saturday and Sunday sitting for the next several months. Please consider signing up for at least one day. Sitters are encouraged to paint or be working on some art project and to greet all visitors. Also, we have a new form to document the number of visitors each day we are open. Attendance figures are critical for the Metroparks to support their applications for grant funding. Please fill out this form before you depart at the end of the day. It is by the sign-up table.

The next Members Meeting is on Monday, October 22, 2018. Steve Stockford, Toledo Botanical Garden Park Supervisor, has tentatively agreed to attend our meeting to update us on the Metropark's plans for TBG.

A new exhibit at the Way Library in Perrysburg is open to all TAC members at no charge. Requirements for this show are the same as all TAC Gallery Shows except that each member is allowed one 2D artwork or two 3D Artworks. We will accept up to forty 2D works and ten 3D works. Three-D works must include any display stand needed. Each piece must have a label with the artist's name, title, medium, price or state NFS if not for sale, and the artist's contact info. Tags must be neat and professional in appearance and attached to the lower right hand corner of the piece. Way library will not handle sales. The library is located at 101 E. Indiana Avenue. Dates: Nov. 1 through 30. (NOTE that the end date may be extended.). At the end of the exhibit, TAC volunteers will return the artwork to the Club for pick up by the artists. Artists will be notified when the works are ready for pick up.

ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists' Club members and area artists.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, sculpture, three-D, ceramics, glass.

Theme Description: Formal or informal sittings of one or more people, presented in any style, from realism to differing degrees of abstraction.

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00
No Refunds **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars).
 Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size: 36" x 48". TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.*

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. **EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD.** Exhibited works must be picked up within 30 days of the show's end.

SALES: **ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.**
 All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 25% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
