**Gallery Shows;** The People and Portrait show reception was held on November 3rd.. The Best in show went to Bruce Watrol for his impressive portrait piece.

**Workshop Committee:** We are still seeking a chairperson for this committee.

Please find it in your heart to fill this post. The Workshops provide excellent learning experiences unique in this area, and are a meaningful source of revenue to the club. You will have my support in carrying out this Chairmanship.

**Club Hosting:** Paula Davis is temporarily coordinating this effort. Also a list of open dates is posted at the club. **Thank you for stepping up and giving your time.** We have committed to the Metroparks that our club doors will be open to visitors on the weekends. The Metroparks count the visitors passing through the park's gates and we are part of that important metric. You can bring your works to display and maybe sell a few of your finest pieces. Bring a sketch pad and do what you like most...DRAWING!!

**We are partnering with the Parkinsons Foundation fund raising event, "Paint the Town", to be held May 14, 2020 at the Toledo Country Club.** Our role is to organize and promote a juried fine art exhibition by creating a call for artists, jurying the entries and awarding the selected winning entries. The judges will be Chris Leeper, Juror for acceptances, and Professor David Guip, Juror for awards. A regional call for artists will be issued via the Showsubmit.com website, and artists will apply using Showsubmit.com. You may submit entries starting January 3<sup>rd</sup>, with a deadline of March 15.

**The entry fee** for TAC members will be \$25 for the first entry, and \$5 for each entry 2-5. Non member entry fees are \$35 for the first entry, \$5 for entries 2-5. We hope to attract 100 entries. **Please consider entering your finest works. Price your artwork to attract a sale price of at least \$500.** The sale price of your artwork will be **divided 50/50 with the Parkinson's Foundation of Northwest Ohio.** The club will receive the entry fees as income. All artwork must be for sale.

We expect that the event will be attended by about 200 patrons ready to purchase the artwork. A preview catalogue will be published and sent to the donors prior to the event. The prospectus will be published on the Showsubmit.com in the near future.. The key planned dates are

**January 3:** Submittal entry begins.

**March 15:** deadline for submittals.

**March 27:** Notification to the artists.

**April 30 to May 3:** Delivery of selected art works to the Toledo Artists club.

**May 12, 13:** Venue set-up; volunteers needed.

**May 14: The Parkinson's Foundation of Northwest Ohio event. The Parkinson's Foundation of Northwest Ohio has cordially invited the accepted artists as their guest to attend the event to represent their work.**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Toledo Artists' Club members and area artists.

**All mediums:** paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, sculpture, three-D, ceramics, glass.

**Theme Description:** Have it your way! Whatever you wish, as long as it's fresh and new.

**ENTRY FEE:** **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00  
**No Refunds** **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

**ENTRIES:** **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to the back top left corner of the piece with the blank side facing out or to the bottom of 3-D works so that the artist's name is not visible. Tape should be Painter's blue tape or equal.  
**TAC IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO ART WORK.**

**ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC** with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars).  
 Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size: 36" x 48". TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.*

**PICK-UP:** Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. **EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD.** Exhibited works must be picked up within 30 days of the show's end.

**SALES:** **ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.**  
 All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 25% commission.

**Tape a label per instructions above. PLEASE** do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
